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Forum Format

The Education for Climate Coalition is the place where the education community at large can engage in co-creation processes for sustainability education.

The forum aims at fostering collaboration between green education stakeholders and to enable the community to thrive within decision-making processes by facilitating a direct dialogue between policymakers and practitioners.

- On the one hand, community members have repeatedly expressed their desire to meet policy experts to better understand the policy background, its ins and outs and opportunities in order to better design concrete green education projects and make them count.
- On the other hand, policy experts need better insights into implementation and experimentation processes within the education community to shape and adapt policy solutions.

This forum will be the occasion to organise such an exchange- and action-driven meeting between green education policy and practice.

The event will kick off with a 50-minute high-level townhall around climate resilience where participants will have the opportunity to engage in the debate.

After a short break, attendees will be introduced to three parallel policy/practice labs, each focusing on a different topic related to climate resilience. These sessions will explore the implications of these changes on both education policy and practice levels, highlighting good practices that can be adopted in response.

The event will conclude with a 30-minute closing session, summarizing the lab sessions and offering follow-up opportunities to participants.

Background

The <u>EducationForClimate Coalition</u> in the European participatory community to support teaching and learning for the green transition and sustainable development.

- As a flagship initiative of the European Education Area by 2025 and essential part of the
 European Green Deal, the Coalition is part of the European Union's comprehensive
 approach to sustainability education. It is run in a cooperation between DGs EAC and JRC.
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- As a community of practice, it enriches both the Council recommendation on learning for the green transition and sustainable development and the sustainability competence framework (GreenComp) with its participatory approach for taking action on education for climate challenges on the ground.
- Our actions, engaging students, teachers and trainers, and education stakeholders from kindergarten to lifelong learning, are centred around <u>five innovation areas</u>: raising awareness, bridging education with science, training teachers, developing green skills and competences in a dedicated sub-community, and changing behaviours.
