GUIDANCE ON ASSESSMENT

Length required is advised above.

Longer work will not be penalized.







However, it should be noted that a concise and professional style which is well focused and clear in the points being made will gain good credit and appreciation.

Originality, quality of argument and good structure are required.

Your submissions will be expected to demonstrate the following qualities:

- 1. Answering the central focus of the assignment open question.
- 2. A critical appreciation of relevant literature and its use to support argument, substantiate model(s) and other aspects of the assignment.
- 3. Taking ownership of the content, being prepared to debate and argue a personal position, evidences evaluative skills.
- 4. Logical flow of ideas and treatment; imaginative approaches; appropriate selection of real world factors related to the model(s) or specific assignment topic.
- 5. Evidence of additional personal experience, if any, and the ability to analyse material from a variety of appropriate relevant perspectives. A clear listing of references and/or bibliography, if any.
- 6. Presentation, structure, appropriateness of methodology, breaking into section headings/subheadings, tidiness.
- 7. A strong conclusion.
