

LET'S MAKE A PHOTO ALBUM TO SHOW OTHER KIDS WHAT LIFE IS LIKE IN OUR CITY!

PEDAGOGICAL OBJECTIVES

1 Discover one's region, ecosystem and the natural resources within them.

2 Get to know other cultures, landscapes and share experiences with others

STEPS

Step 1 : Get familiar with the fresco

- Look at the fresco in detail and linger on areas that draw your interest and color them in.

Step 2 : Reflect on the Daily Camp Schedule

- How did you get to summer camp? Which mode of transportation did you take? ⇒ *Take a picture of each child to represent each mode of transport taken.*
- What will we eat at camp? Where is our food coming? How did it get here? ⇒ *Investigate: Have the children interview the person in charge of providing their lunch and ask them these questions.*
- Where do you live?

Step 3 : Link Activities to the Fresco

- Read the schedule of activities for the week or the month and link them to places and objects that we see in the fresco

Step 4 : Take Photos of These Moments

- Organize a photo scavenger hunt with parental consent
- During the course of the week, take photos of all the elements seen in the fresco and that exist in the neighborhood or city where the children live.
 - Examples: Take pictures of the train station, community gardens, beehives, ride-sharing station, farmer's market, etc.

Step 5 : Place the photos on the fresco of an imaginary city.

- Take a photo of the fresco with all the added photos and upload it to the platform.

Step 6 : Discover

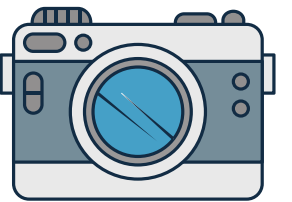
- Discover the frescoes from other regions and discuss your findings with other students.

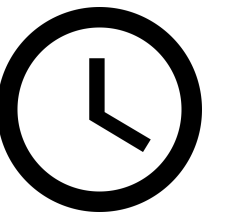
