School mobility in Flanders/Belgium

14 children are involved in a road crash on their way to school, every day!

5100 children have a traumatic experience in traffic, each year

53% of all parents of children between 5-18 years old assess the school routes as dangerous

But **70%** of all children in Flanders are going to school by bike or another active mode of transport.

1. TELRAAM NETWORK

Through research and citizen science gathering objective and subjective traffic data.

2. SCHOOL PACKAGES

Educational materials to gain insight in (local) mobility challenges, traffic data & to design creative solutions.

3. DESIGN WORKSHOP

Children are triggered to identify challenges, to think solution-oriented together and to develop concepts to inspire adults


4. PLAYGROUND TALKS

Children share dreams & experiences with all stakeholders to develop mobility solutions in local neighbourhood.



5. PARTICIPATION WORKSHOPS

Opening up the discussion with neighbours, local governments, schools, parent councils, police, interest groups ...



6. TEST AND EVALUATE

Selected measures are tested, monitored and evaluated through Telraam, surveys and observations.
